Course overview: *Introduction to Croatian Language A1.1*

This introductory course offers a practical and structured approach to learning Croatian at the beginner level. It is intended for students with no prior knowledge of the language who wish to acquire essential communication skills and gain a basic understanding of Croatian culture. The course emphasizes everyday language use, with a focus on pronunciation, sentence construction, and basic interaction in common situations.

Students will become familiar with core vocabulary and expressions used in personal introductions, daily routines, and simple conversations. It is suitable for those planning to study, travel, or work in Croatia, and serves as a foundation for continued language learning at higher levels.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Understand and apply the basics of the Croatian phonetic system and pronunciation.
- Use common everyday expressions and basic phrases for simple interactions.
- Introduce themselves and exchange personal information in Croatian.
- Ask and answer simple questions on familiar topics.
- Develop and use vocabulary related to family, professions, countries, colours...

- Construct and comprehend simple sentences in both spoken and written Croatian.
- Recognize and apply foundational grammatical rules in communication.
- Write and understand short, simple messages.

Technical Requirements: Laptop/PC with a stable Internet connection, a camera and a microphone. Lessons will be held via Microsoft Teams/Zoom.
